The smoking and vaping ban applies to:

- f ensure that the whole school community understands that smoking is banned on school premises and within 4 metresof school entrances
- f remind the school community that smoking is banned at school premises
- f encourage Department employees who require support complying with the ban to use the Employee Assistance Program (EAP)d contactConvergenternational(1800 337 06)
- f if necessary, arrange training workshops withit Victoria (03 9635 552) on how to support staff and young people to quit
- f if advice is required about the drug education policy, curriculum learning strategies and the process of responding to a young person who has been smoking at school refer to the smoke free schools resources at the Better HealthChannel
- f make tobacco education information available

Vaping and Electronic cigarettes (igarettes) are Banned:

- f It is illegal to obtain, possess or useigarettes, or their cartridges, which contain nicotine in Victoria.
 On this basis students, teachers and employees of the Departarentanned from possessing or using e-cigarettes, or their cartridges, containing nicotine on school grounds.
- f It is illegal in Victoria to obtain, possess or usegarettes that do not contain nicotine.
